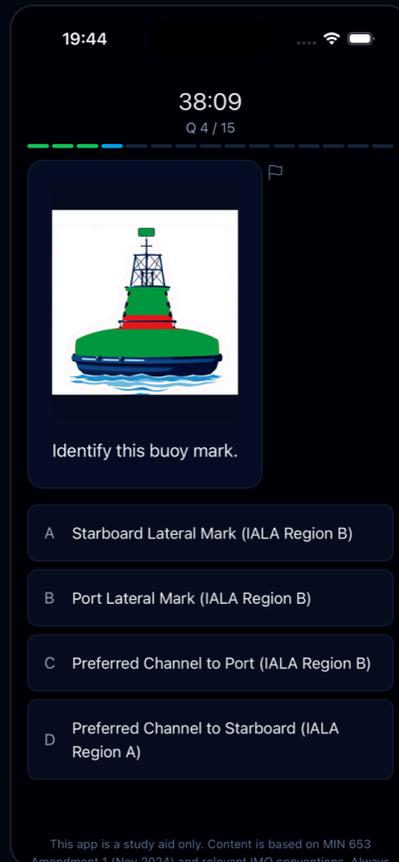

ARPA (Automatic Radar Plotting Aid) Automatic Radar Plotting Aid
A radar system that automatically acquires and tracks targets, computing and displaying their course, speed, closest point of approach (CPA) and time to CPA (TCPA). Mandatory on vessels over 10,000 GT under SOLAS. Processes relative or true motion data and provides collision-avoidance decision support. [SOLAS V/19]

ALPHABET FLAGS (A - Z)

Alpha Blue & White swallowtail
I have a diver down; keep well clear at slow speed.

Bravo Red swallowtail
I am taking in, or discharging, or carrying dangerous goods.

Charlie Blue/White/Red/White/Blue horizontal stripes
YES - affirmative or "The significance of the previous group should be read in the affirmative".

Delta Yellow, Blue & Yellow vertical thirds
Keep clear of me - I am manoeuvring with difficulty.

Echo Blue & Red horizontal halves
I am altering my course to starboard.

Foxtrot Red with white diamond
I am disabled; communicate with me.

Radar Principles & Display

TIP
Exam tip: You must know the difference between relative motion and true motion displays, and when each is most appropriate for collision avoidance versus navigation.

Radar performance can be affected by atmospheric conditions such as super-refraction (extended range in temperature inversions) and sub-refraction (reduced range). The radar horizon is approximately 6% greater than the visual horizon due to the normal refraction of radar waves. Blind sectors and shadow sectors caused by the vessel structure must be identified and documented.

REMEMBER
Remember the radar range equation: maximum detection range depends on target size, target aspect, antenna height, atmospheric conditions, and sea state. A small wooden vessel may not be detected even at close range.

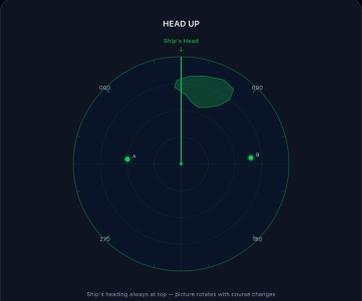

Radar Principles & Display

Display Modes
Radar displays can be presented in several modes. Head-up mode shows the ship heading at the top of the screen and is the simplest to interpret but targets smear when the vessel alters course. North-up mode stabilises the display to true north using gyro compass input, eliminating target smear during course changes. Course-up mode places the current heading at the top but re-oriens when a significant course alteration is made. True motion mode shows own ship moving across the display, providing the most realistic picture of the traffic situation.

3. Use spaced repetition for the stuff you keep getting wrong. The app tracks what you're weak on and brings those topics back more often.
